

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-0707

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SPOKANE COUNTY, WASHINGTON AMENDING SPOKANE COUNTY CODE SECTION 46.61.4155.2

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Washington, Spokane County, Washington ("County") is a class A county duly organized and existing; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 36.01.030, the powers of Spokane County can only be exercised through the Board of County Commissioners of Spokane County, Washington ("Board"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 36.32.120(6), the Board has the care of County property and the management of County funds and business; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 36.32.120(7), the Board may make and enforce by ordinance all such police and sanitary regulations that are not in conflict with state law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 46.08.020, the Board may adopt vehicle and traffic regulations that are not in conflict with title 46 RCW; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has conducted a Traffic Engineering Study as to revise and extend the 25 mph speed limit on 17th Avenue and Glenrose Road; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has recommended that reducing the speed limit would serve the best interests of the public; and

WHEREAS, having held a public hearing and taken testimony on this matter, the Board agrees with the County Engineer's recommendation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Spokane County, Washington, that Spokane County Code Section 46.61.4155.2 be amended as follows:

Delete from Section No. 46.61.4155.2 Twenty-Five miles per hour.

Glenrose Road – Havana-Yale Road to Spokane City Limits

Add to Section No. 46.61.4155.2 Twenty-Five miles per hour.

17th Avenue – Spokane City Limits to Havana-Yale Road
Glenrose Road – Havana-Yale Road to Big Spring Road

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Board that the County Engineer is directed and authorized to cause to be posted and maintained signs in accordance with SCC 46.61.5701 and the Washington State Department of Transportation's "Manual for Signing."

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Board that this Ordinance shall take effect upon the placement of said signs.
