

AN ORDINANCE NO. 9974

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND GRANITE CITY MUNICIPAL CODE,
TITLE 12.04, GENERAL PROVISIONS, SECTION 12.04.070 REPAIRS**

WHEREAS, the City of Granite City is a Home Rule unit pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Illinois State Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, Section 12.04.070 governs repairs to all public streets, alleys, and sidewalk pavement; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined there have been instances where repairs to public streets, alleys, and sidewalk pavement have been made, and the citizens of Granite City would have been better served had specific standards for pavement repairs and patching been in effect; and

WHEREAS, the Building and Zoning Department, and the City Engineers believe it is in the best interest of the City of Granite City to amend Section 12.04.070 of the Municipal Code to add detailed schematics regarding the required concrete patch technique to be enforced by the City; and

WHEREAS, it is believed the proposed Amendment will result in an improved street patch that will not settle over time, and will match the color of the surrounding surface area; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Amendment is as follows:

12.04.070 REPAIRS.

A. Construction or repair work performed on public streets, alleys, or sidewalk pavement done by an abutting owner, utility, or a third-party contractor, shall be performed pursuant to permit and under the supervision of the Director of Public Works, and in accordance with the Concrete Patch Detail for street, alley, or sidewalk pavement repair provided by the City of Granite City, Building and Zoning Department.

All repairs shall be placed full depth and flush with the existing surface whether it be concrete, bituminous, or oil and chip surface.

All repairs or patches shall be stained to match the existing surrounding surface. If a public street is to be repaired, removed, or replaced, whether in order to facilitate street repair, replacement, construction, for work related to a utility, or otherwise, the removal and replacement of the pavement shall be to the nearest curb line, center line, or lane line as indicated on the attached Exhibit. The amount of pavement removed and replaced shall be at minimum one-half a lane width.

B. Before excavating, digging, or trenching within one hundred feet of any electric traffic signal or City-maintained streetlights, any person, firm, contractor, utility, or individual so excavating, digging or trenching shall first apply for, and obtain a permit from the Building and Zoning Administrator.

C. As used in this Section, "Utility" includes but is not limited to infrastructure or service of water, storm drainage, electric, sanitary sewer, gas, telephone, cable television, fiber optic, communications, or other main, whether publicly or privately owned, operated, or serviced.

D. The permit applicant shall demonstrate to the building and Zoning Administrator, that the applicant has successfully determined the exact location of all underground electric cables and electric conductors within five (5) feet of any proposed excavating, trenching, or digging. In the event electric cable or electric conductors are damaged during or as a result of any dig, excavation, or trenching, the permit applicant shall replace the entire length of cable or conductor to the satisfaction of the Building and Zoning Administrator.

Splicing below grade will not be permitted.

WHEREAS, the Concrete Patch Detail for the street, alley, or sidewalk pavement repair is attached to this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Granite City City Council is desirous of approving the attached Amendment; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Granite City, of the County of Madison and State of Illinois, that Granite City Municipal Code Section 12.04.070 is hereby amended as stated above.


This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and may be published in pamphlet form by the City Clerk.



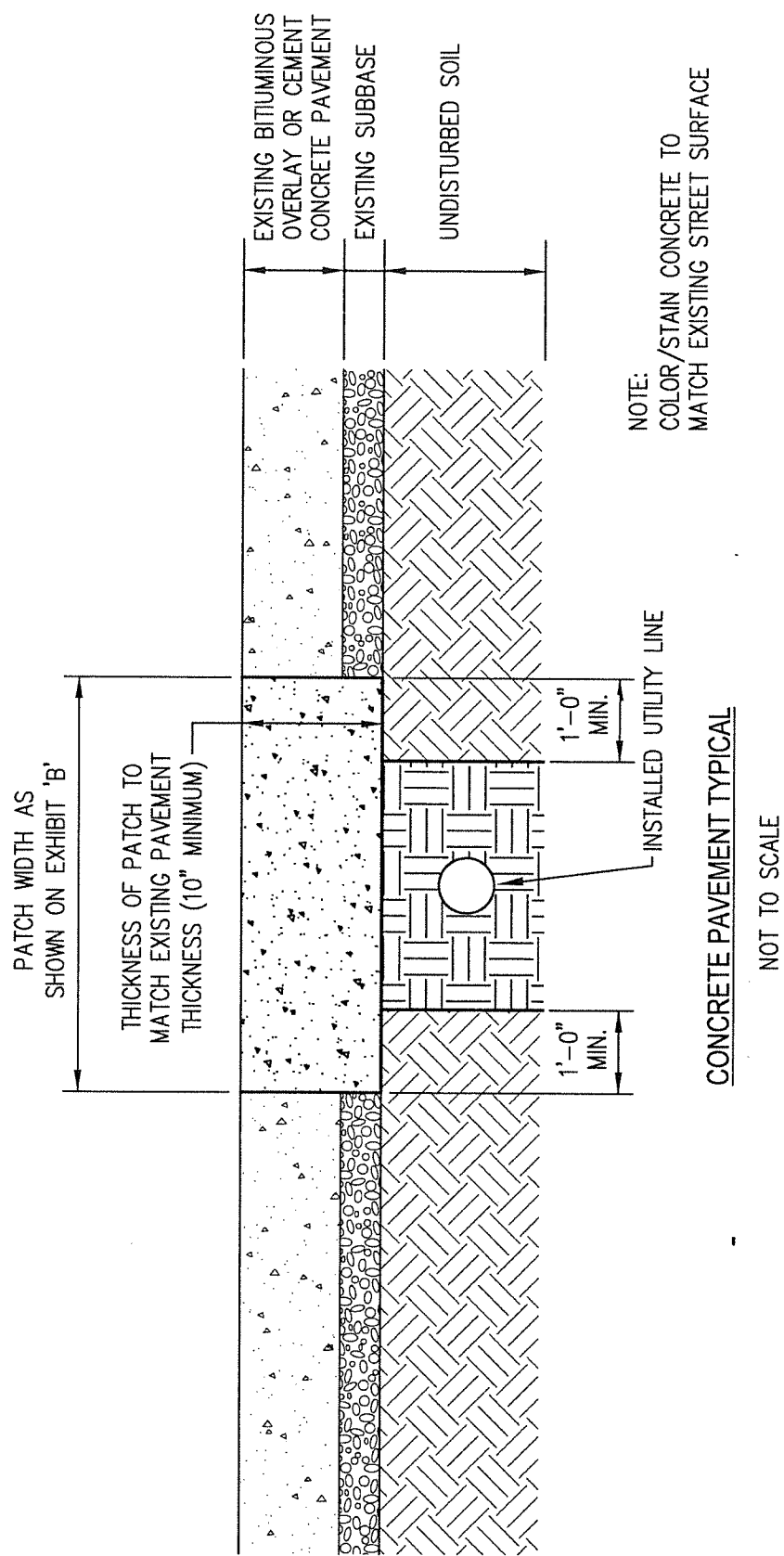

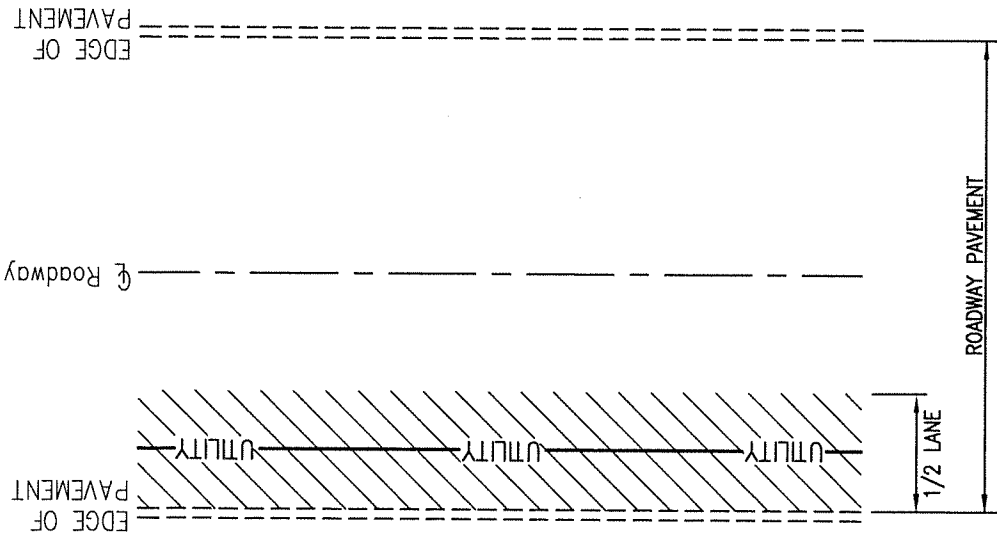

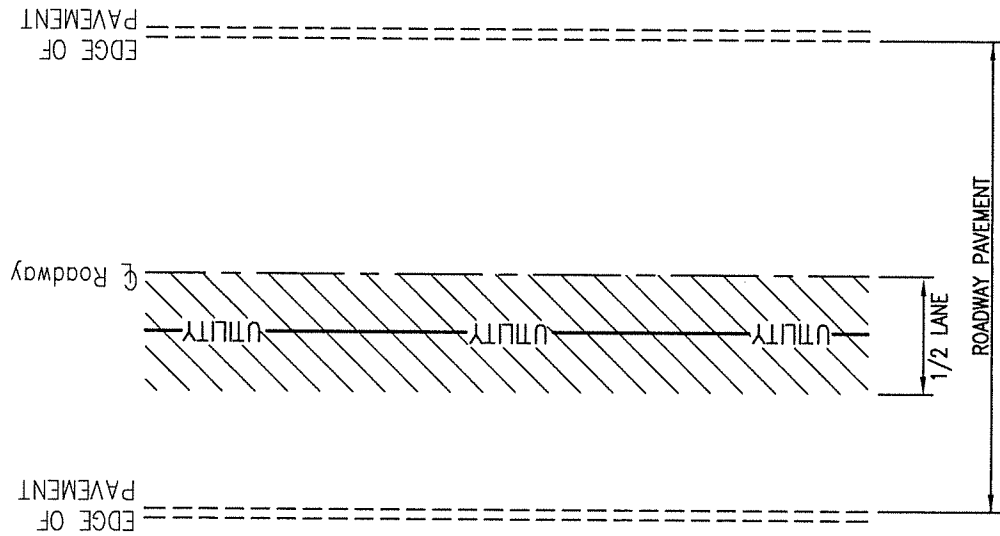

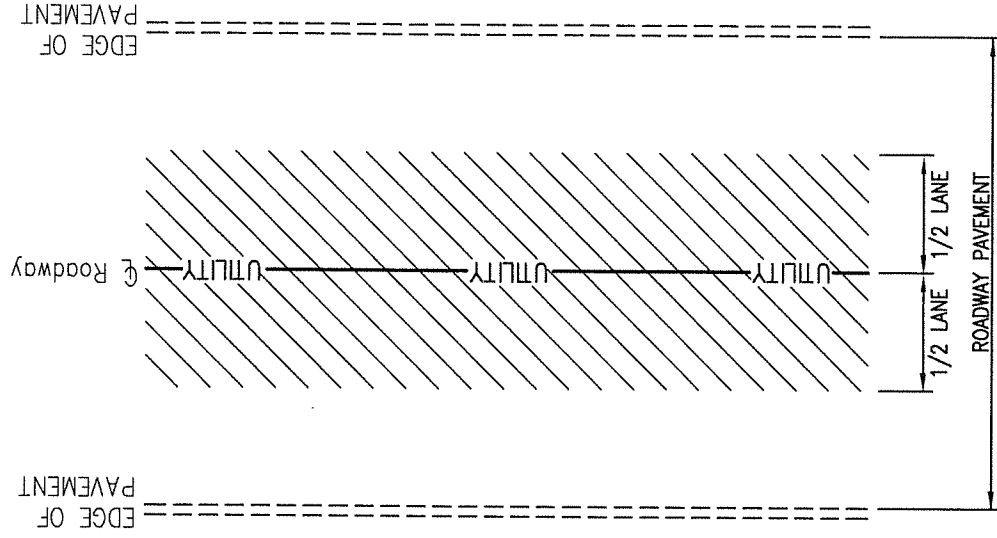




EDGE OF PAVEMENT INSTALLATION
