ORDINANCE NO. 2025-ORD-064

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5 BUSINESS TAXES, LICENSES AND REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 5.04 ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR DEALERS OF THE CITY OF GRANITE CITY MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the City of Granite City, Illinois (the “City”) is a municipal corporation and a home-rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1, provides that the corporate authorities of each municipality may pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary, to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the City desired to incorporate BASSET training requirements into the City Code to enforce responsible alcohol service practices within the City; and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities have determined it is in the best interests of the City and residents to amend the City’s Municipal Code as provided herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANITE CITY, MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: RECITALS. The facts and statements contained in the preamble of this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: AMENDMENTS. The Codified Ordinances of the City of Granite City, Title 5, Chapter 5.04, Section 5.04.190 is hereby amended as follows (strikethrough text indicates deletions; underlined text indicates additions):

5.04.190: ~~RESERVED~~ ILLINOIS BASSET ALCOHOL CERTIFICATION PROGRAM:

A. Completion Required: Successful completion of a BASSET program, or other similar program as approved by the Illinois Liquor Control Commission, is required for all persons who sell or serve alcoholic liquor, all management personnel working in a licensed premises, and anyone whose job description entails the checking of identification for the purchase of alcoholic liquor pursuant to the license.

B. New Owners, Managers, Employees: Any new owner, manager, employee or agent requiring BASSET training shall, within thirty (30) days from their first day of employment or other association with a licensee, enroll in a BASSET approved program and then complete the program successfully within sixty (60) days of enrollment. Until successful completion of the program, such person shall work under the direct supervision of a person who is BASSET certified.

C. Term Of Validity: BASSET certification or other approved training shall be valid only for three (3) years or such shorter time as may be specified by the certification program. After the certification expires, recertification is required. If there is a lapse in certification, the individual must work under the direct supervision of a person who is BASSET certified. Any lapse in certification of more than sixty (60) days shall be a violation of this section.

D. Certificates Maintained: Photocopies of certificates of completion of a BASSET program shall be maintained by the licensee in a manner that will allow inspection, upon demand, by a member of the Police Department or the Local Liquor Control Commission.

SECTION 3: HEADINGS/CAPTIONS. That the headings of the articles, sections, paragraphs and subparagraphs of this Ordinance are inserted solely for the convenience of reference and form no substantive part of this Ordinance, nor should they be used in any interpretation or construction of any substantive provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: PUBLICATION. That this ordinance shall be published in accordance with all applicable state and local laws. Copies of this ordinance shall be made available to the public upon request at the City Clerk's office.

SECTION 5: SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.


SECTION 6: CONFLICT. Any ordinances, resolutions, and parts of ordinances and resolutions in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.


