**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 21-3.7 OF CHAPTER 21 OF THE
ORDINANCE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF LAKE BY ADOPTING A
SECTIONAL DISTRICT ZONING MAP NO. 3.7(b) 1. ⁴⁰⁶**

REZONING THE LANDS FOR THE REYNOLDS SYSTEMS, INC.

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LAKE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 21-3.7 of Chapter 21 of the Ordinance Code of the County of Lake is hereby amended by the adoption of Sectional District Zoning Map Number 3.7.(b)1. ⁴⁰⁶; so as to Rezone **18649 CA State Highway 175, Middletown, CA 95461** being further described as **Assessor Parcel Numbers 013-046-04**, Lake County Records, Lake County, California.

Section 2: The Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered the environmental effects of the as set forth in the Initial Study and Negative Declaration (IS 23-03) which was adopted for this rezoning and finds, on the basis of the initial study and any comments received, that there is no substantial evidence that the project will have a significant effect on the environment.

Section 3: This rezoning is consistent with the Lake County General Plan and the Middletown Area Plan.

Section 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and no further.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect on the **28th day of November 2023** and within fifteen (15) days after adoption of the ordinance, the Clerk to the Board of Supervisors shall publish a summary of the ordinance with the names of those supervisors voting for and against the ordinance and the Clerk shall post in the office of the Clerk to the Board of Supervisors a certified copy of the full text of the adopted ordinance along with the names of those supervisors voting for and against the ordinance.
