SECTION 1. The Zoning Map of the County of San Joaquin, as amended, is hereby further amended by reclassifying property from AU-20 (Agricultural Urban Reserve, 20-acre minimum) to R-L (Low Density Residential) as shown on Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The Community Development Director shall revise the Zoning Map of the County of San Joaquin in accordance with Section 1 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after its adoption and prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the passage thereof, shall be published once (1) in the Stockton Record, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Joaquin, State of California, with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same.
