

ORDINANCE NO. 506

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH,  
CALIFORNIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 457 OF  
SAID CITY (RELATING TO BOULEVARDS AND BOULE-  
VARD STOPS) BY ADDING A NEW SUBDIVISION TO  
SECTION 2 OF SAID ORDINANCE, TO BE KNOWN AND  
DESIGNATED AS "SUBDIVISION 366".

The City Council of the City of Manhattan Beach, Cali-  
fornia, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 457 of the  
City of Manhattan Beach, California, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH,  
CALIFORNIA, FIXING AND ESTABLISHING CERTAIN  
BOULEVARDS AND BOULEVARD STOPS WITHIN SAID  
CITY, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS  
OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.",

passed and adopted on the 17th day of June, 1937, shall be and the  
same is hereby amended by adding a new subdivision thereto to be  
known and designated as "Subdivision 366", and which said new Sub-  
division 366 shall read as follows, to-wit:

"Subdivision 366. West Railroad Drive and Agnes Road,  
South Easterly entrance."

SECTION 2. That said Ordinance No. 457 is hereby amended  
as hereinabove in Section 1 of this ordinance set forth.

SECTION 3. That the City Clerk shall certify to the  
passage and adoption of this ordinance; shall cause the same to be  
entered in the book of original ordinances of said City; shall make  
a minute of the passage and adoption thereof in the records of the  
meeting at which the same is passed and adopted; and shall, within  
fifteen days after the passage and adoption thereof, cause the same  
to be published once in the Manhattan Beach News, a weekly newspaper  
of general circulation, published and circulated within said City

1 of Manhattan Beach, and which is hereby designated for that purpose.

2 SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and  
3 be in full force and virtue at midnight on the 30th day from and  
4 after the date of the adoption thereof.
