

ORDINANCE NO. 603

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH,
CALIFORNIA, amending ORDINANCE NO. 590 OF
SAID CITY AND THE "UNIFORM ELECTRICAL CODE"
ADOPTED BY SAID ORDINANCE NO. 590, BY ADDING
A NEW SECTION TO SAID ELECTRICAL CODE TO BE
DESIGNATED AS SECTION 17.1 RELATING TO A
BOARD OF EXAMINERS AND APPEALS.

The City Council of the City of Manhattan Beach, California,
does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That a new section, to be designated and known
as "Section 17.1", shall be and the same is hereby added to the
"Uniform Electrical Code" adopted by Ordinance No. 590 of said
City, entitled:

"AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH,
CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A UNIFORM ELECTRICAL
CODE IN AND FOR SAID CITY, AND ALSO ADOPTING
THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE THEREIN REFERRED
TO."

passed and adopted on the 26th day of August, 1948, and which said
new "Section 17.1" shall read as follows, to-wit:

"SECTION 17.1. In order to determine the suitability of
alternate materials and construction and to provide for
reasonable interpretations of the provisions of this Code,
and for reasonable variances therefrom where same are
found necessary in order to provide for unusual or extra-
ordinary conditions which may arise, the Board of Examiners
and Appeals provided for in Ordinance No. 588 of the City
of Manhattan Beach, as amended, (as said Board now exists
or may hereafter be constituted), shall be and the same is
hereby constituted and appointed as the Board of Examiners
and Appeals under this 'Uniform
Electrical Code', and the Building
Inspector shall be the Secretary of said Board.


1 Said Board of Examiners and Appeals shall have and
2 exercise the same authority, functions and powers, and right
3 to make determinations with reference to subjects and matters
4 covered and referred to in this 'Uniform Electrical Code'
5 as it has and exercises with reference to subjects covered
6 under the Building Code of the City of Manhattan Beach
7 and notices of its meetings shall be given in the same
8 manner as provided in said Building Code."

9 SECTION 2. That said Ordinance No. 590 and the "Uniform
10 Electrical Code" adopted thereby are hereby amended as hereinabove
11 in Section 1 of this ordinance set forth.

12 SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be
13 in full force and virtue thirty days from and after the date of the
14 final passage and adoption thereof.

15 SECTION 4. That the City Clerk shall certify to the pass-
16 age and adoption of this ordinance; shall enter the same in the book
17 of original ordinances of said City; shall make a minute of the
18 passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of
19 the City Council of said City in the minutes of the meeting of said
20 Council at which the same is passed and adopted; and shall, within
21 fifteen (15) days after the passage and adoption thereof cause the
22 same to be published once in the Manhattan Beach News, a weekly news-
23 paper of general circulation, published and circulated within the said
24 City of Manhattan Beach, and which is hereby designated for that pur-
25 pose.
