ORDINANCE NO. 834

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH, CALIFORNIA, 3 ADOPTING THE MANHATTAN BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE, TOGETHER WITH THE FOLLOWING SECONDARY CODES THEREIN ADOPTED BY 4 REFERENCE, TO WIT: THAT CERTAIN CODE ENTITLED, "FIRE PREVENTION CODE EDITION OF NINETEEN FIFTY-THREE", 5 ESTABLISHED BY THE NATIONAL BOARD OF FIRE UNDERWRITERS OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, SAVE AND EXCEPT SUCH PORTIONS THEREOF AS ARE DELETED, MODIFIED OR AMENDED 6 BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE; 7 THAT CERTAIN CODE ENTITLED, "UNIFORM BUILDING CODE 1958 EDITION VOLUME III", PUBLISHED BY THE PACIFIC COAST 8 BUILDING OFFICIALS CONFERENCE OF LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA, SAVE AND EXCEPT SUCH PORTIONS THEREOF AS ARE DELETED. 9 MODIFIED OR AMENDED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE; THAT CERTAIN CODE ENTITLED, "UNI-FORM ELECTRICAL CODE" PUBLISHED BY THE PACIFIC COAST 10 ELECTRICAL BUREAU, 1947 EDITION AND THAT CERTAIN CODE 11 ENTITLED, "1947 NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE", SAVE AND EXCEPT SUCH PORTIONS THEREOF AS ARE DELETED, MODIFIED OR AMENDED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH 12 MUNICIPAL CODE; AND THAT CERTAIN CODE ENTITLED, "UNI-13 FORM PLUMBING CODE 1958 EDITION", PUBLISHED BY THE WESTERN PLUMBING OFFICIALS ASSOCIATION OF LOS ANGELES. 14 SAVE AND EXCEPT SUCH PORTIONS THEREOF AS ARE DELETED. MODIFIED OR AMENDED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE MANHATTAN 15 BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE; PRESCRIBING CERTAIN PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS THEREOF; AND REPEAL-16 ING CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS SPECIFIED THEREIN.

18 The Council of the City of Manhattan Beach does ordain 19 as follows:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF THE MANHATTAN BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE. 20 That certain document entitled, "MANHATTAN BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE". 21 including the Appendix thereto, three (3) copies of which have been 22 filed and are on file in the office of the City Clerk for public 23 inspection, together with the secondary codes therein adopted by 24 reference, is hereby adopted as a comprehensive ordinance code for 25 the City of Manhattan Beach, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 26 50022.1 through 50022.7 of the Government Code of the State of 27 California. Each and all of the provisions, terms and penalties of 28 said Code on file in the office of the City Clerk are hereby referred 29 to, adopted, incorporated herein, and hereby made a part hereof as 30 if fully set forth in this ordinance. 31

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SECTION 2. REPEAL OF ORDINANCES. Except as otherwise pro-

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vided in this ordinance and in the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code, all ordinances of the City of Manhattan Beach in force upon the effective date of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. CERTAIN ORDINANCES TO REMAIN IN EFFECT. Those certain ordinances of the City of Manhattan Beach which are listed in Tables 2, 3 and 4 of the Appendix to the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code shall not be repealed by this ordinance, but shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. EXCEPTIONS TO REPEALS. No rights, obligations, duties, privileges or encumbrances arising from any ordinance which is repealed by this ordinance and which said ordinance relates to any of the following matters shall be affected by the repealing provisions of this ordinance or of the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code:

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(a) The public debt or the public credit;

(b) The establishment, naming, width, grade, construction, improvement or vacation of a public street, sidewalk, alley or other public property or facility;

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(c) The annexation of territory;

(d) Any contract to which the City is a party or any contract inuring to the City's benefit;

(e) The acquisition or disposition of any interest in real or personal property;

(f) A municipal election;

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(g)Any appropriation or expenditure of public funds:

The levy or imposition of property taxes or fixing 27 the tax rate:

(h)

Levying of a special benefit assessment or creating a (1)lien or debt against the owner of any property or said property; or

30 (1)The granting of any franchise, license or right by the 31 City, which license, grant, power or franchise is legally in force 32 and effect upon the effective date of this ordinance. Every such

license, grant and power or franchise shall expire as originally provided.

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SECTION 5. SAVINGS PROVISIONS. The repealing provisions of this ordinance or of the Manhattan Beach Municipal Code shall not affect or impair any act done or right vested or approved or any proceeding, suit or prosecution had or commenced in any cause before such repeal shall take effect; but every such act done, or right vested or accrued, or proceeding, suit or prosecution had or commenced shall remain in full force and effect to all intents and purposes as if such ordinance or part thereof so repealed had remained in force. No offense committed and no liability, penalty or forfeiture, either civilly or criminally incurred prior to the time when any such ordinance or part thereof shall be repealed or altered by said Code, shall be discharged or effected by such repeal or alteration; but prosecutions and suits for such offenses, liabilities, penalties or forfeitures shall be instituted and proceeded with in all respects as if such prior ordinance or part thereof had not been repealed or altered.

SECTION 6. VIOLATION OF CODE. It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any provision, or fail to comply with any requirement of said Code. Any person violating any of the provisions or failing to comply with any of the mandatory requirements of said Code shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Any person convicted of a misdemeanor under the provisions of said Code shall be punishable by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail or the County Jail for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each such person shall be guilty of a separate offense for each and every day during any portion of which any violation of any provision of said Code is committed, continued or permitted by such person and shall be punishable accordingly. In addition to the penalties hereinabove provided, any

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1 2	condition caused or permitted to exist in violation of any of the
2 3	provisions of said Code shall be deemed a public nuisance and may
4	be, by this City, summarily abated, and each day such condition
5	continues shall be regarded as a new and separate offense.
6	SECTION 7. PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance
7	shall be published once in the Manhattan Beach News within fifteen
8	(15) days from and after its adoption and shall take effect and be
9	in force thirty (30) days from and after its adoption.
10	The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a regular meeting
11	of the City Council of the City of Manhattan Beach held on the
12	3rd day of March, 1959, and finally passed and adopted by said
13	Council at a regular meeting held on the 7th day of April, 1959,
