The Council of the City of Manhattan Beach, California, does ordain as follows:

SEC. 3-11.1510. Stopping, standing or parking prohibited during certain hours on certain streets.

1. Highland Avenue between the northerly line of Homer Street and the northerly boundary line of the City.

Westerly side-Tuesday and Friday

Easterly side-Monday and Thursday

Westerly side-Tuesday and Friday

Easterly side-Monday and Thursday

Northerly side-Monday and Thursday

Southerly side-Tuesday and Friday

1 5. Marine Avenue between the westerly line of Manor Drive
2 and the easterly line of The Strand.

3 Northerly side-Monday and Thursday

4 Southerly side-Tuesday and Friday

5 6. Valley Drive from the easterly line of Oak Avenue to the
6 westerly line of Sepulveda Boulevard.

7 Northerly side-Monday and Thursday

8 7. Fifteenth Street between the westerly line of Highland Avenue
9 and the easterly line of Ocean Drive.

10 Northerly side-Monday and Thursday

11 Southerly side-Tuesday and Friday

12 8. 38th Street between the westerly line of Highland Avenue and
13 the easterly line of The Strand.

14 Northerly side-Monday and Thursday

15 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall go into
16 effect and be in full force and operation from and after thirty (30) days
17 after its final passage and adoption.

18 SECTION 3. PUBLICATION. The City Clerk shall certify to
19 the passage and adoption of this ordinance; shall enter the same in the
20 book of original ordinances of said City; shall make a minute of the passage
21 and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings of the City Council
22 at which the same is passed and adopted; and shall within fifteen days
23 from the passage and adoption thereof cause the same to be published
24 once in the Manhattan Beach News, a weekly newspaper of general circu-
25 lation, published and circulated within said City of Manhattan Beach and
26 which is hereby designated for that purpose.
