

1 charms, potions, magnetism or magnetized articles or
2 substances, oriental mysteries or magic of any kind or
3 nature, or numerology.

4 (c) No person shall advertise by sign, circular,
5 handbill or in any newspaper, periodical magazine, or
6 other publication, or by any other means, any business
7 named in paragraph (b) above, or any business of a like or
8 similar nature.

9 (d) The provisions of this section shall not be con-
10 strued to conflict in any way with the approved conduct of
11 any public exhibitions or demonstrations of sleight of hand
12 or any acts connected with the art of prestidigation.

13 (e) The provisions of this section shall not be con-
14 strued to include, prohibit or interfere with the exercise
15 of any religious or spiritual function of any priest, minister,
16 rector or an accredited representative of any bona fide church
17 or religion where such priest, minister, rector or accredited
18 representative holds a certificate of credit, commission or
19 ordination under the ecclesiastical laws of a religious corpo-
20 ration incorporated under the laws of any state or territory
21 of the United States of America or any voluntary religious
22 association, and who fully conforms to the rights and practices
23 prescribed by the supreme conference, convocation, convention,
24 assembly, association or synod of the system or faith with
25 which they are affiliated. Provided, however, that any church
26 or religious organization which is organized for the primary
27 purpose of conferring certificates of commission, credit or
28 ordination for a price and not primarily for the purpose of
29 teaching and practicing a religious doctrine or belief, shall
30 not be deemed to be a bona fide church or religious organization."

31 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall go into
32 effect and be in full force and operation from and after thirty days after

1 its final passage and adoption.

2 SECTION 3. PUBLICATION. The City Clerk shall certify to
3 the passage and adoption of this ordinance; shall cause the same to be
4 entered in the book of original ordinances of said City; shall make a
5 minute of the passage and adoption thereof in the records of the meeting
6 at which the same is passed and adopted; and shall within fifteen days
7 after the passage and adoption thereof cause the same to be published
8 once in the Manhattan Beach News, a weekly newspaper of general
9 circulation, published and circulated within said City of Manhattan Beach
10 and which is hereby designated for that purpose.
