1 of said Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 SEC. 9-14.02. Application for permit.

3 Any non-profit organization desiring a permit as
4 required pursuant to the provisions of Section 9-14.01 of this
5 chapter shall file an application with the Department of Public
6 Works. Such application shall set forth the name and address
7 of the applicant, the description of the location and area of
8 the proposed installation or suspension, and a statement of
9 the purpose for which such installation or suspension is to be
10 maintained. The application shall be signed by the applicant
11 and shall contain a statement that the applicant agrees to con-
12 form to and obey all of the provisions of this chapter and all
13 regulations of the Council relative to the installation of such
14 devices. Said application shall also contain a certification
15 by the applicant that no individual personal or corporate profit
16 shall result from the banner publicity other than as a parti-
17 cipating merchant in an area-wide sale or general community
18 event.

19 SECTION 3. Section 9-14.03 of Chapter 14, Title 9
20 of said Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

21 SEC. 9-14.03. Permit fees.

22 The schedule of fees for permits issued pursuant
23 to the provisions of this chapter is as follows: For the hang-
24 ing, sustaining, or suspension of any street banner, flag,
25 pennant, or street decoration or other devices and renewal
26 thereof, Forty and no/100ths (\$40.00) Dollars for each banner
27 if accomplished by City forces; or Ten and no/100ths (\$10.00)
28 Dollars for each banner if accomplished by any other agency.
29 The Council may waive any such fee.

30 SECTION 4. Section 9-14.04 of Chapter 14, Title 9
31 of said Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

1 SEC. 9-14.04. Granting or denial of permit.

2 The application shall be presented to the City
3 Manager or his designated representative for consideration.
4 The City Manager or his designated representative may take such
5 application under advisement pending its consideration thereof
6 and may grant subject to such conditions as considered appro-
7 priate or refuse to grant any such permit. Said decision shall
8 be subject to appeal to the City Council.

9 When the application shall have been approved
10 by the City Manager or his designated representative, the per-
11 mit shall be issued jointly by the Chief Building Inspector
12 and the Public Works Director.

13 SECTION 5. Section 9-14.07 of Chapter 14, Title 9
14 of said Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

15 SEC. 9-14.07. Suspension and revocation of permit.

16 (a) *Cause.* In the event any person holding a
17 permit to hang, sustain, or suspend any street banner, flag,
18 pennant, or street decoration over and above any street or
19 other public thoroughfare in the City shall violate any con-
20 dition of such permit, or any provisions of this chapter, the
21 City Manager or his designated representative, in their dis-
22 cretion, may suspend for a stated period or revoke such per-
23 mit issued to such person. If the permit shall be revoked,
24 the City Manager or his designated representative, in their
25 discretion, may thereafter refuse to grant to such person a
26 permit for such person in the City.

27 (b) *Hearing required.* No permit shall be
28 suspended or revoked until a hearing shall have been held by
29 the City Manager or his designated representative in the matter
30 of the revocation of such permit upon not less than ten (10)
31 days written notice to the applicant or permittee.

32 (c) *Nontransferable.* The permittee shall not

1 assign his permit, or any interest thereto, without first
2 obtaining the written consent of the City Manager or his
3 designated representative, nor shall such permit, or any
4 interest therein, be transferred by operation of law. Any
5 such assignment or transfer shall be void and shall confer
6 no right of occupancy upon the assignee or transferee. In
7 the event the permittee shall be adjudicated a bankrupt or
8 become insolvent, or in the event possession of any interest
9 in such permit shall be taken by virtue of any writ, the
10 City Manager or his designated representative may terminate
11 such permit.


12 (d) *Notice to abate and remove.* Upon the
13 termination, suspension, or revocation of such permit, the
14 permittee shall, upon demand of the City, remove the cables
15 and cable attachments. Upon revocation of the permit with
16 respect to specific cable locations, the permittee shall, upon
17 demand of the City, remove such cable and attachments from
18 such specific locations. In the event the permittee shall
19 fail to remove any cables and cable attachments, or portions
20 thereof, upon demand of the City, the City may remove such
21 cables and cable attachments, and the permittee shall reimburse
22 the City for its costs of removal.

23 SECTION 6. This ordinance shall go into effect and
24 be in full force and operation from and after thirty days
25 after its final passage and adoption.

26 SECTION 7. The City Clerk shall certify to the
27 passage and adoption of this ordinance; shall enter the same
28 in the book of original ordinances of said City; shall make a
29 minute of the passage and adoption thereof in the records of
30 the proceedings of the City Council at which the same is
31 passed and adopted; and shall within fifteen days from the
32 passage and adoption thereof cause the same to be published

1 once in the Manhattan Beach News, a weekly newspaper of general
2 circulation, published and circulated within said City of
3 Manhattan Beach and which is hereby designated for that purpose.
