2	AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH, CALIFORNIA, PROHIBITING THE COM-
3	MENCEMENT OF ANY BUSINESS WHICH IN WHOLE OR IN PART IS REQUIRED TO LIMIT, EXCLUDE
4	OR REGULATE ITS COMMODITIES OR SERVICES FROM MINORS PENDING CONSIDERATION BY THE
5	PLANNING COMMISSION AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING OR-
6	DINANCE REQUIRING SUCH USES TO BE PER- MITTED ONLY PURSUANT TO ISSUANCE OF A
7	CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT, SAID ORDINANCE TO BE ADOPTED AS AN URGENCY ORDINANCE
8	PURSUANT TO SECTION 65858 OF THE GOVERN- MENT CODE.
9	
10	WHEREAS, the City's Community Development Department
11	has recommended for consideration by the Planning Commission
12	and City Council a proposed amendment to the City Zoning Ordi-
13	nance relative to businesses which in whole or in part are re-
14	quired to limit, exclude or regulate its commodities or ser-
15	vices from minors; and
16	WHEREAS, the Director of Community Development at
17	the City Council meeting of November 4, 1975 requested that
18	the City Council adopt a moratorium on the installation of
19	said uses pending consideration by the City Planning Commission
20	and City Council of said proposed ordinance; and
21	WHEREAS, Section 65858 of the Government Code of the
22	State of California authorizes the adoption of an interim
23	ordinance as an emergency measure prohibiting any usage of
24	land which may be in conflict with a contemplated zoning
25	proposal which the legislative body or Planning Commission is
26	considering or studying or intends to study within a reasonable
27	period of time;
2 8	NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
29	MANHATTAN BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
30	SECTION 1. No uses shall be commenced or established
31	or altered to such a point where a building permit is required
32	where such use involves a business which in whole or in part is

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required to limit, exclude or regulate its commodities or
 services from minors, pending study and determination of a
 proposed ordinance requiring that said uses may be established
 or altered only pursuant to issuance of a conditional use
 permit or until this ordinance or any extension thereof have
 expired.

This ordinance is adopted as an urgency SECTION 2. 7 measure to protect the public safety, health and welfare and 8 take effect upon its adoption and shall continue in effect 9 for a period of no longer than four months; provided, however, 10 that after notice pursuant to Section 65856 of the Government 11 Code and a public hearing, the City Council may extend the 12 effectiveness of this ordinance for a period of eight months 13 14 and thereafter for an additional period of one year.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage 15 16 and adoption of this ordinance; shall enter the same in the book 17 of original ordinances of said City; shall make a minute of the passage and adoption thereof in the records of the proceedings 18 19 of the City Council at which the same is passed and adopted; and 20 shall within fifteen days from the passage and adoption 21 thereof cause the same to be published once in the Manhattan 22 Beach News, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, publish-23 ed and circulated within said City of Manhattan Beach and which 24 is hereby designated for that purpose.
