

ORDINANCE NO. 3802

AN ORDINANCE OF COUNTY OF MARIN, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING ANGLE PARKING, ADA ACCESSIBLE PARKING, AND A NO PARKING ZONE ON A PORTION OF 3RD STREET, POINT REYES STATION

**THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF MARIN DOES HEREBY
ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Findings.

The Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

1. Pursuant to section 22503 of the California Vehicle Code (CVC), local jurisdictions may by ordinance permit angle parking on any roadway.
2. The Board of Supervisors finds it is in the interest of public safety and accessibility that angle parking shall be established on the southeasterly side of 3rd Street and with the addition of angle parking will also include two ADA accessible spaces.
3. Pursuant to section 22507 of the CVC, local jurisdictions may by ordinance or resolution restrict parking on public roads.
4. The Board of Supervisors further finds that restricting parking is necessary to provide adequate space for cars to safely back out of the angled parking and therefore finds that a no parking zone shall be created on the northwesterly side of 3rd Street.

SECTION 2. It is hereby determined and declared as follows:

1. Angle parking shall be allowed at all times on the southeasterly side of 3rd Street beginning at the intersection of State highway 1 and extending southwesterly for approximately 100 feet,
2. Two of these angle parking spaces shall be established as ADA accessible spaces designated for use by vehicles displaying a valid handicap parking permit, and
3. A no parking zone shall be created on the northwesterly side of 3rd Street beginning at the intersection of State Highway 1 and extending southwesterly for approximately 90 feet.

SECTION 3: Effective Date and Publication

This ordinance shall be, and is hereby declared to be, in full force and effect from and after (30) days after the date of its passage and shall be published once before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, with the names of the Supervisors

voting for and against same, in the *Marin Independent Journal*, a newspaper of general circulation, published in the County of Marin, and when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected upon the street.
