ORDINANCE NO. 4481

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.30.010 OF THE MORRIS MUNICIPAL
CODE REGARDING NO PARKING REGULATIONS
(WATER STREET PARKING)**

WHEREAS, the City of Morris is authorized to regulate the parking and standing of vehicles within the corporate limits of the City of Morris (625 ILCS 5/11-205);

WHEREAS, the City of Morris is further authorized to regulate the use of the streets and other municipal property (65 ILCS 5/11-80-2);

WHEREAS, the Morris Street and Alley Committee has recommended that the south side of Water Street shall be designated as a "no parking" area;

WHEREAS, the Morris City Council has considered the recommendation of the Street and Alley Committee, and has determined that the no parking regulations contained herein would be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Morris.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MORRIS, GRUNDY COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the above recitals constitute the findings of the Morris City Council and hereby restated and incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as though fully set forth herein.

2. That Section 10.30.010 (N) is hereby amended, and shall hereafter include the following:

51. On the south end of Water Street (dead end) extending 25 feet north on the east side of Water Street and extending 25 feet north on the west side of Water Street.

3. The Director of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to purchase and install signs consistent herewith, and to post the same at the above designated location following passage, approval and publication hereof. The city shall also undertake any necessary roadway striping.

4. The Morris City Clerk is authorized and directed to publish a true and correct copy of this Ordinance in pamphlet form for a period of not less than ten days.

5. Any Ordinance or Resolution inconsistent with the terms and provisions hereof is hereby repealed and revoked to the extent of any such inconsistencies.

6. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately from and following its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
