**ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF  
SURPLUS VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT OWNED BY THE CITY OF MORRIS,  
GRUNDY COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Morris Finance and Administration Committee has recommended the sale of surplus equipment within the Morris Public Works Department as they are no longer necessary or useful to the City of Morris;

WHEREAS, the Morris Finance and Administration Committee has recommended the turning in as part of the purchase price of the surplus vehicles within the Morris Police Department as they are no longer necessary or useful to the City of Morris;

WHEREAS, the City of Morris is authorized to sell or turn in surplus property no longer necessary or useful by the authority granted to the City of Morris in the Illinois Municipal Code, *65 ILCS 5/11-76-4*;

WHEREAS, the Morris City Council having considered the recommendations of the Finance and Administration Committee has determined that the sale of the surplus vehicles and equipment is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Morris.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND MORRIS CITY COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Morris City Council hereby finds and determines that the above recitals are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the City finds that continued ownership of the following equipment of the Morris Public Works Department is no

longer necessary or useful to the City of Morris, and the best interests of the City will be served by the sale of the following:

- 2008 Dodge Grand Caravan, VIN # 1D4HN11H88B162010
- 1989 International Cab Chassis Blue #1954 2T, VIN # 1HTLDTVN4KH644728

Section 3. The Public Works Department equipment set forth in Section 2 above shall be sold at public auction to the highest bidder with Richie Brothers, Morris, Illinois.

Section 4. Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, the City finds that continued ownership of the following vehicles of the Morris Police Department are no longer necessary or useful to the City, and the best interests of the City will be served by their trade in:

- 2014 Ford Explorer, VIN # 1FM5K8AR7EGA75767
- 2017 Ford Explorer, VIN # 1FM5K8AR1HGA35978
- 2015 Ford Explorer, VIN # 1FM5K8AR0FGA28467
- 2015 Ford Explorer, VIN # 1FM5K8AR2FGA28468
- 2009 Dodge Durango, VIN # 1D8HB38P29F707063

Section 5. The Morris Police Department vehicles set forth in Section 4 above shall be turned in as part of the purchase price on a purchase from D'Orazio Ford, Wilmington, Illinois.



Section 7. This Ordinance shall be effective from and following its passage and approval as required by law.

Section 8. Any Ordinances inconsistent with the terms and provisions hereof are hereby repealed and revoked to the extent of any such inconsistency.
