**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.04 OF THE MUNDELEIN MUNICIPAL CODE
TO ESTABLISH AN INDIVIDUAL PUBLIC COMMENTARY TIME RESTRICTION POLICY**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Village of Mundelein to amend Section 2.04.120 of Chapter 2.04 of the Mundelein Municipal Code to establish an individual public commentary time restriction policy for regular and special meetings of the Village Board; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MUNDELEIN, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that:

Section I. Section 2.04.120, Addressing officers at meetings, of Chapter 2.04, MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, of the Mundelein Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.04.120 – Addressing officers at meetings.

Any person may, upon being recognized by the chair, address the mayor and board of trustees at any regular or special meeting. Any persons recognized by the chair to address the mayor and board of trustees during the public commentary portion of any regular or special meeting shall be limited to no more than five minutes of public commentary time per person, per meeting. The aforementioned individual public commentary time restriction may be waived at any regular or special meeting at the discretion of the chair.


Section II. Severability. If any section, clause, paragraph, or provision of this Ordinance shall be found invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgement shall not affect, impair, invalidate, or nullify the remainder of this Ordinance, but only that part found invalid by such court.

Section III. Repeal of Prior Ordinances. All prior Ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

Section IV. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


