ORDINANCE NO. O-25-04-26

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 8 OF THE MUNDELEIN MUNICIPAL CODE: FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, the Village of Mundelein, Lake County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a home rule municipality as contemplated under Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village’s home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, subject to said Section, a home rule unit may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mundelein is an Illinois home rule municipal corporation organized and operating pursuant to Article VII of the Illinois Constitution of 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Village has established various fees and charges as part of the Mundelein Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Village determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to create a comprehensive fee schedule in the Mundelein Municipal Code to consolidate into one chapter all of its various fees and charges rather than having the various fees and charges set forth in various provisions throughout the Municipal Code or other ordinances, rules, regulations, and policies; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2024, the Village board passed ordinance 24-10-50 to create a comprehensive fee schedule that established various fees and charges as part of the Mundelein Municipal Code into one chapter, Chapter 3.80 where fees and charges could be reviewed from time-to-time; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mundelein Finance Department has conducted a review of the charges, fees and licenses charged by the Village for the 2025/2026 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the costs of the business registration fee and subsequent late fees have been revised to offset administrative costs, with an effective date of the increase: July 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the costs of the tree removal fee has been revised to more closely reflect inflationary changes and the actual cost of the service provided; and

WHEREAS, on April 14, 2025, the water fees were approved for a 5% increase to cover the cost increase for water services from Central Lake County Joint Action Water Association, with an effective date of the increase: June 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interests of the Village to update the village fee schedule and implement the new fees effective June 1, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MUNDELEIN, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS HOME RULE AUTHORITY, as follows:

SECTION I: The Village Board hereby amends the Mundelein Municipal Code so that the following portions of Title 3, Chapter 8, Fee Schedule are amended to reflect the proposed fees and effective dates as stated in the attached Exhibit A, where specific changes are redlined.

Reference to 14.04 Water and Sewer Rates: Effective June 1, 2025

Reference to 5.04.060 Business Registration Late Fee: Effective July 1, 2025

Reference to 5.08.020 Business Registration Fee: Effective July 1, 2025

SECTION II: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION III:: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form (which publication is hereby authorized) as provided by law.
