ORDINANCE NO. 4653

**Adopt an Ordinance Providing for a Speed Limit
of 30 Miles Per Hour on a Portion of North Highway 99 Frontage Road East**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Joaquin ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to Section 22358 of the Vehicle Code, it is hereby determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic survey that the speed limit of 30 miles per hour is reasonable and safe upon the portion of the County road described in Section 2 hereof, and it is further determined and declared reasonable, safe, and more appropriate to facilitate the orderly movement of traffic along the said portion of the County road.

SECTION 2: Subparagraph (35) is hereby added to Section 10-2101 of the Ordinance Code of San Joaquin County to read as follows:

- (35) That portion of North Highway 99 Frontage Road East, beginning at the north right-of-way line of Acampo Road, thence running northerly along North Highway 99 Frontage Road East for a distance of 1,670 feet, more or less.

SECTION 3: The Director of Public Works shall have signs erected giving notice of the foregoing speed limit upon said County road.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its adoption, and prior to the expiration of 15 days from the passage thereof shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation, published in the County of San Joaquin, State of California, with the names of the members of the Board voting for and against the same.
