ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10.12 ENTITLED SPEED LIMITS OF THE TAMPICO MUNICIPAL CODE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the Village Council of the Village of Tampico, Whiteside County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 10.12 entitled "Speed Limits" in Title 10 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", is hereby repealed and shall hereinafter be amended to state in its entirety as follows:

10.12.010. Definitions.

An Alley is defined as a public way within a block, generally giving access to the rear lots or buildings and not used for general traffic circulation.

Street is defined as the entire width between boundary lines of every way publicly maintained when any part thereof is open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel.

10.12.020. General Restriction.

No person shall drive a vehicle upon any Street or Alley in the Village at a speed greater than is reasonable and proper, having regard to the traffic and the use of the Street or Alley or so as to endanger the life or limb or injure any person or property; nor at a speed greater than the applicable maximum speed limit established by law, ordinance, or regulation.

10.12.030. Due care required; when speed reduction required.

The fact that the speed of a vehicle is lower than the applicable maximum speed shall not relieve the driver from the duty to decrease speed when approaching and crossing an intersection; when approaching and going around a curve; when approaching a hillcrest; or when special hazard exists with respect to pedestrians, other traffic, or by reason of weather or highway conditions. Speed shall be diminished as may be necessary to avoid colliding with any person or property at all times. It is the duty of pedestrians and drivers to at all times use due care.

10.12.040. Maximum speeds designated.

- (A) The maximum speed limit upon all Streets in the Village over which the state has maintenance responsibility shall be that fixed by law, or a duly empowered agency or department of the state; otherwise, speed limits are as follows:
 - (1) The maximum speed limit upon Main Street in the Village is 30 miles per hour.
 - (2) The maximum speed limit upon all Streets other than Main Street is 25 miles per hour.
 - (3) The maximum speed limit upon all Alleys is 15 miles per hour.

(4) The maximum speed limit in any school speed zone, as designated by the Village Council, shall be 20 miles per hour.(5) The maximum speed limit in any park or cemetery is 10 miles per hour.
Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective after the passage and publication of this Ordinance in pamphlet form.
