

RESOLUTION NO. 703

A RESOLUTION BY THE WOODLAND CITY COUNCIL ABOLISHING THE WOODLAND TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT AND CONFIRMING THAT THE WOODLAND CITY COUNCIL IS VESTED WITH ALL RIGHTS, POWERS, IMMUNITIES, FUNCTIONS AND OBLIGATIONS OTHERWISE PREVIOUSLY VESTED BY LAW IN THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE WOODLAND TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT, AS ALLOWED BY RCW 36.74

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Woodland adopted Ordinance No. 1363 creating the Woodland Transportation Benefit District with the same boundaries as the City limits; and

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2018, the Woodland Transportation Benefit District recommended that the City Council assume these rights, powers, functions and obligations and abolish said District; and

WHEREAS; on June 4, 2018, the City Council passed Resolution No. 701, indicating its intention to conduct a hearing concerning its proposed assumption of such rights, powers, functions and obligations and therein scheduled a public hearing on said subject for June 18, 2018, allowing all persons interested therein to appear and be heard; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution No. 701 was published at least two times during the two weeks prior to June 18, 2018, in a newspaper of general circulation printed or published in the City of Woodland; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2018, said public hearing was held; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2018, the City Council (1) considered the assumption of the rights, powers, functions, and obligations of the Woodland Transportation Benefit District, (2) held a public hearing on the matter, and (3) then determined that the public interest or welfare would be satisfied by the City assuming the rights, powers, immunities, functions, and obligations of the Woodland Transportation Benefit District; and

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2018, the City Council thereby assumed the rights, powers, immunities, functions and obligations of the Woodland Transportation Benefit District; and


WHEREAS, on June 18, 2018, pursuant to Resolution No. 702, the City was vested with every right, power, immunity, function, and obligation granted to or possessed by the Woodland Transportation Benefit District, as provided by RCW 36.74.030;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Woodland City Council:


1. That the Woodland Transportation Benefit District is hereby abolished as provided by RCW 36.74.030.
