

## Chapter 10.36 - WINTER PARKING

### 10.36.010 - Time period regulations to be in effect.

Effective each year from **November 15th to May 1st**, the winter parking regulations set out in this chapter will be in effect in the town.

### 10.36.020 - Removal of vehicles from streets—Excepted streets.

- A. Upon announcement by the United States Weather Bureau or forecast in the public newspaper or on radio or television of an expected or impending snowstorm, all automobiles and motor vehicles must be removed from the town streets. Any automobile or motor vehicle not removed shall be subject to the penalty of being tagged and fined for violation of the town parking regulations and/or being towed away at the expense of the owner, operator or responsible person, with the exception of the following streets:

Name of Street	Location
Bowdoin Street	Odd numbered side from Buchanan Street to Bates Avenue
Brookfield Road	Even numbered side of street
Morton Street	Marsh side of street
River Road	Even numbered side of street
Seaview Avenue	Even numbered side of street
Siren Street	Odd numbered side of street <b>from the Easterly property line of 19 Siren Street to Triton Avenue.</b>
Veterans Road	Golf Club side (angle parking prohibited)
Waldemar Avenue	Odd numbered side of street <b>from Wheelock Street to Pleasant Street</b>
Walden Street	Fence side from Main Street to Lincoln Street and Ingleside Park side from Lincoln Street to Pauline Street

Winthrop Street	Odd numbered side from Magee's Corner to Banks Street

- B. Motor vehicles must be removed from these excepted streets immediately upon cessation of snow during daylight hours or, in the case of storm events occurring during the nighttime hours, by eight a.m. in order not to impede snow removal operations. Violators will be subject to the same penalty as above.

10.36.030 - Persons responsible to keep informed.

Persons responsible for parking automobiles must keep informed at all times of snowstorm forecasts in order that vehicles may be properly removed from town streets.

10.36.040 - Obstruction of streets.

Town bylaw prohibits anyone from obstructing the public street or sidewalk without a permit from the town council. Therefore, any chairs, barrels, traffic cones or other objects placed in the public way to "reserve" parking spaces will be removed and disposed of immediately.

10.36.050 - Lost tickets.

All towed vehicles are tagged and ticketed for violating town parking regulations. If a vehicle is towed and the ticket is lost during this process, the vehicle owner or the person responsible for the vehicle should contact the parking clerk to determine if additional fines are owed.
