ORDINANCE 1417

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING IN PART PORTIONS OF THE CURRENT CODE OF THE CITY OF SENECA, KANSAS, REGULATING AND ESTABLISHING THE TIME AND DATE FOR MUNICIPAL COURT SESSIONS

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Seneca, Kansas:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 1383 is hereby repealed; and **Section 1.32.095 Session-Time, place.** of the Municipal Code of the City of Seneca, Kansas is hereby amended by the adoption of the following in its place and stead; and, any other provisions of said City Code or city ordinance which are inconsistent with the provisions herein are hereby repealed.

Section 2. That **Section 1.32.095 Session-Time, place.** of the Code of the City of Seneca, Kansas shall be amended to read as follows:

- A. Effective October 13, 2021, Municipal Court for the City of Seneca, Kansas, shall be held in regular session on the third Wednesday each month at 4:00 o'clock PM, except as otherwise scheduled by the Municipal Judge.
- B. Municipal Court for the City of Seneca, Kansas, shall be held in the municipal courtroom which is annexed to City Hall located at 6th and Main Streets, in the City of Seneca, Kansas.
- C. The Municipal Judge shall have the authority to set and establish hearing dates for municipal court proceedings at such times and dates as necessary in addition to the regularly scheduled court sessions set forth herein.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication once in the official city newspaper.
