ORDINANCE NO. 24,742

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE GENERAL SCHEDULE OF FEES, AMENDING SECTIONS 60-38-13, 60-38-14, 60-38-15, 60-38-17, 60-38-18, 60-38-20 AND 60-38-21 OF ARTICLE IV OF TITLE 38 OF CHAPTER 60 OF THE OKLAHOMA CITY MUNICIPAL CODE, 2010, BY AMENDING: FEES FOR USE OF CITY PARK BUILDINGS; FEES FOR USE OF CITY OPEN AIR PAVILIONS; ADMISSION FEES FOR MARTIN PARK NATURE CENTER TOUR; FEES FOR OTHER PERMITS AND RESERVATIONS; FEES FOR USE OF AMPHITHEATERS; FEES FOR USE OF WILL ROGERS ROSE GARDENS, AND FEES FOR SERVICES AND USE OF PARK EQUIPMENT.

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OKLAHOMA CITY:

SECTION 1. That Sections 60-38-13, 60-38-14, 60-38-15, 60-38-17, 30-38-18, 60-38-20 AND 60-38-21 of Article IV, Title 38, Chapter 60 of the Oklahoma City Municipal Code, 2010, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Non-refundable processing fee* (inclusive)	20.00
Special processing fee for pavilion and stadium reservations made less than seven calendar days in advance	20.00
Off-season cleaning deposit**	100.00

*For a rental with a fee less than \$20,00 the non-refundable processing fee will be considered the amount of the rental.

*A cleaning deposit is required for all off-season pavilion rentals. Pavilions are winterized during the off-season, October 31st to April 15th, and do not have running water. The cleaning deposit will be refunded provided the pavilion is left clean and in such condition as to allow activities to continue as scheduled. Governmental agencies will be exempt from paying the cleaning deposit, however if they facility is not left clean and in such condition as to allow rentals to continue as scheduled the agency will be billed for the amount of the cleaning deposit.

A \$20,00 key deposit fee is required for all applicable picnic shelters and pavilions. Key deposits will be refunded provided keys are picked up prior to the event and returned within three working days of the use. Governmental agencies will be exempt from paying the key deposit, however if the key deposits not returned within the three working days of the use the agency will be billed \$20,00 for the key.

Cancellations - Refunds for pavilion and stadium rentals, minus \$20.00, will be given if a cancellation notice is received in the Parks Administration office at least seven calendar days before the scheduled event.

If the notice is less than seven calendar days, an alternate date within the current season may be chosen at no additional charge, but no refund will be given. If no notice of cancellation is given no refund will be given.

If weather conditions (heavy rain, hail, freezing precipitation or tornado warning) prohibit the use of a reserved pavilion or stadium an alternate date can be selected at no additional charge, or a refund, minus \$20.00, will be given.

Cancellations - Refunds for Will Rogers Rose Gardens, Arboretum and Ed Lycan Conservatory and Plaza rentals, minus \$20.00, will be given if a cancellation notice is received in the Parks Administration office at least seven calendar days before the scheduled event. If the notice is less than seven calendar days, an alternate date, within six months, may be chosen at no additional charge, but no refund will be given. If no notice of cancellation is given no refund will be given.

If weather conditions (inclement weather) prohibit the use of a reserved garden, an alternate date can be selected at no additional charge, or a refund, minus \$20.00, will be given.
