Section 6-3-5, “General Parking Regulations”, and
Section 6-3-6, “Parking During Snowfall Operations”

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village find that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to amend the provisions of Title 6, “Motor Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Village of Barrington Village Code, relative to parking regulations within the Village as set forth herein:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington, Cook and Lake Counties, Illinois, that:

SECTION 1: The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby find that the recitals hereinabove set forth are true and correct and are incorporated into the text of this Ordinance as its findings to the same extent as if each such recital had been set forth herein in its entirety.

SECTION 2: That portion of the Chart in Subparagraph B, “Lot Designations”, of Section 6-3A-7, “Parking Lots, Parking Areas, Permits and Tags Designated”, of Article A, “Village Parking Lots”, of Chapter 3, “Parking Regulations”, of Title 6, “Motor Vehicles and Traffic”, relative to Village parking lot number 23 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Lot Number	Use	Location and Restrictions
* * * *		
23	Shopper/ Barrington Village Center	Located on the west side of Hough Street between Main Street and Station Street, Lot 23 consists generally of three hour shopper parking each day from 6:00 a.m. until 2:00 a.m. the next day, except that five (5) spaces shall each be reserved for persons with disabilities displaying a current, valid disability license plate, parking placard, or parking decal or device, ten (10) parking spaces shall each be limited to 15 minute parking, 20 twenty (20) spaces shall each be restricted to the parking of vehicles displaying a valid employer/employee premium (“A”) parking permit, and two (2) more of the employer/employee premium parking spaces shall be <u>restricted to parking spaces</u> reserved for low emission vehicles. The employer/employee parking spaces in Lot 23 may <u>also</u> be used for valet parking by valet services which have a current certificate of valet registration issued by the Chief of Police, or his designee, beginning at 5:00 p.m. each day until 2:00 a.m. the next day. On each day of the week, there shall be no parking in Lot 23 from 2:00 a.m. until 6:00 a.m.

SECTION 3: The Corporate Authorities of the Village intend that this Ordinance will be made part of the Village Code and that sections of this Ordinance can be renumbered or relettered and the word “Ordinance” can be changed to “Section”, “Article”, “Chapter”, or some other appropriate word or phrase to accomplish codification, and regardless of whether this Ordinance is ever codified, the Ordinance can be renumbered or relettered and typographical and/or scrivener’s errors can be corrected with the authorization of the Village Attorney, or his or her designee.

SECTION 4: All parts of the Barrington Village Code in conflict with the terms or provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby amended or repealed to the extent of such conflict, and said Village Code and all other existing ordinances shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall not affect any punishment, discipline, infraction, or penalty or any action based on any other Ordinance of this Village incurred before the effective date of this Ordinance, nor any suit, prosecution or proceeding pending at the time of the effective

date of this Ordinance, for an offense or violation committed or cause of action arising before this Ordinance, and said other ordinances as heretofore existing shall continue in full force and effect for said limited purpose.

SECTION 6: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance or any part thereof is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, or any part thereof. The Corporate Authorities hereby declare that they would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentence, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

SECTION 7: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

SECTION 8: The Village Clerk is directed to immediately publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.
