ORDINANCE NO. 2025-99

AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING AND REINSTITUTING THE DISCOUNTS SET FORTH IN ORDINANCES 2625-92 AND 2763-93 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in 1992, the North Ridgeville City Council adopted Ordinance 2625-92, which authorized the Mayor to enter into a three-year agreement for the collection and disposal of refuse throughout the City with BFI; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2625-92 also included, among other things, a one-dollar (\$1.00) discount for senior citizens who applied and were approved by the North Ridgeville Utilities Department and a one-dollar (\$1.00) discount for those designated as disabled and/or disadvantaged (under the federal poverty level); and

WHEREAS, the contract was for the period 1992-1994; and

WHEREAS, in 1993, the North Ridgeville City Council adopted Ordinance 2763-93, which amended 2625-92 to include a one-dollar (\$1.00) discount to those who apply and are qualified for the Homestead Exemption; and

WHEREAS, all other terms and conditions set forth in 2625-92 were to remain in effect; and

WHEREAS, both ordinances 2625-92 and 2763-93 were codified into N.R.C.O. Section 1060.07, Collection Rate Discounts and Waivers; and

WHEREAS, neither Ordinance 2625-92, 2763-93, nor N.R.C.O. Section 1060.07 included an automatic renewal clause or made the discounts permanent in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Ridgeville has been approving the discounts set forth in N.R.C.O Section 1060.07 since 1993 and wish to continue with said discounts on a permanent basis.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The North Ridgeville City Council hereby ratifies any and all discounts that have been provided under either Ordinance 2625-92, 2763-93, and N.R.C.O. Section 1060.07 since 1993.

SECTION 2. The senior citizen and Homestead Exemption discounts as set forth in Ordinance 2625-92, 2763-93, and N.R.C.O. Section 1060.07 are to be permanent in nature unless and until the North Ridgeville City Council subsequently amends this legislation.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were conducted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in accordance with all legal requirements, including §121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being in order to ratify and reinstitute the discount for the welfare of the community. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
