

ORDINANCE NO. 1236

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAMAR, COLORADO AMENDING THE ADMINISTRATION, VICTIMS AND WITNESSES ASSISTANCE AND LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD BY AMENDING SUBSECTION (7) OF 2-256.

WHEREAS, the cost to repair property damaged during the commission of the crime has continued to go up due to increases in labor and materials; and

WHEREAS, the deductibles on car insurance has continued to increase; and

WHEREAS, the cost for medical expenses has continued to increase; and

WHEREAS, in order to further meet the needs of individuals who are the victims of crimes, the V.A.L.E. board wishes to increase the maximum reimbursable amount to \$750.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAMAR, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

Chapter 2, Article VI, Section 2-256 shall be repealed and reenacted as follows:

Sec. 2-256 (7) Purpose of disbursement

Losses resulting from property damage, including repair or replacement of property damaged as a result of crime or payment of the deductible amount of a residential or motor vehicle insurance policy shall be paid in an amount not to exceed \$750.00 per claim. In no case shall a loss be compensable if the aggregate damage property damages are less than \$25.00.

Should any part of this Ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall remain in full force and effect.
