

COUNCIL BILL NO. 19-007
ORDINANCE NO. 4678

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BY
AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF WHEAT RIDGE AND THE CITY OF ARVADA
REGARDING ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT IN THE WHEAT RIDGE - WARD
ROAD STATION AREA

WHEREAS, C.R.S. § 29-1-203 and Colorado Constitution Article XIV § 18(2)(a) authorize and enable governments of the State of Colorado to cooperate and contract with one another to provide any function, service, or facility lawfully authorized to each; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Transportation District completed a commuter rail station in Wheat Ridge near the intersection of Taft Court and Ridge Road, also referred to as the Wheat Ridge – Ward Road Station (the “Station”); and

WHEREAS, future development of real property surrounding the Station and extending into the territorial jurisdiction of both parties and share an interest in planning, designing, and constructing improvement that mutually serve the short and long-term interests of the parties; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement to plan, design, and construct the transportation infrastructure and roadway improvements for the 52nd Avenue and Ridge Road Improvements.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ARVADA, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Mayor, or the Mayor Pro-tem is hereby authorized to execute, the City Clerk to attest, in form approved by the City Attorney, an Intergovernmental Agreement, which is substantially the same form as that attached hereto, by and between the City of Wheat Ridge and the City of Arvada.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective five days after publication following final passage.
