

ORDINANCE NO. 0250-20-ORD

AN ORDINANCE OF THE LEWISVILLE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE LEWISVILLE CITY CODE CHAPTER 15, TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, SECTION 15-104, TRUCKS, BY EXPANDING THE SEGMENT OF CHURCH STREET ON WHICH THE OPERATION, LEAVING, PARKING, OR STANDING OF VEHICLES WITH MORE THAN TWO AXLES IS PROHIBITED TO INCLUDE THE SECTION OF CHURCH STREET BETWEEN MILL STREET AND KEALY AVENUE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER, SEVERABILITY, PENALTY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lewisville, Texas, has determined that for the health, welfare, and safety of its citizens, amending Chapter 15, Section 15-104 of the Lewisville City Code is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Chapter 15, Section 15-104 of the Lewisville City Code is hereby amended by deleting the following street segment:

<i>Street Segment</i>	<i>Extent</i>
Church Street	From its intersection with Mill Street to its intersection with Herod Street

SECTION 2. Chapter 15, Section 15-104 of the Lewisville City Code is hereby amended by adding the following street segment:

<i>Street</i>	<i>Extent</i>
Church Street	From its intersection with Kealy Avenue to its intersection with Herod Street

SECTION 3. REPEALER. Every ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, or phrases of this ordinance, but they shall remain in effect.

SECTION 5. PENALTY. Any person, firm or corporation who violates any provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof in the Municipal Court of Lewisville, Texas, shall be subject to a fine of not more than two hundred (\$200.00) dollars for each offense.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.

SECTION 7. EMERGENCY. It being for the public welfare that this ordinance be read passed creates an emergency and public necessity, and the rule requiring this ordinance be read on three separate occasions be, and the same is hereby waived, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication, as the law in such cases provides.
