

ORDINANCE NO. 3816-11-2010

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 15, ARTICLE II, SECTION 15-36.2; MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS FOR SPECIAL SCHOOL ZONE AREAS; OF THE LEWISVILLE CITY CODE; ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL SPEED ZONE ON LAKE PARK ROAD; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING A REPEALER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lewisville, Texas, has determined that for the health, welfare, and safety of its citizens, and upon engineering and traffic investigation studies conducted by the State of Texas and adopted by the City Council of the City of Lewisville, Texas, speed limits upon the listed streets shall be as stated herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEWISVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Chapter 15, Article II, of the Lewisville City Code is hereby amended as follows by adding:

Sec. 15-36.2. Maximum speed limits for special school zone areas.

<i>Street/Road/Highway</i>	<i>Extent</i>	<i>Speed (mph)</i>
Lake Park Road (School Zone)	From 485 feet east of Oakridge Boulevard to 985 feet east of Oakridge Boulevard	20

SECTION 2. PENALTY. Any person, firm or corporation who violates any provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof in the Municipal Court of Lewisville, Texas, shall be subject to a fine of not more than Five Hundred

(\$500.00) Dollars for each offense, and each and every day such offense is continued shall constitute a new and separate offense.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. Every ordinance or parts of ordinances found to be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall for any reason be held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, or phrases of this ordinance, but they shall remain in effect.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and publication as required by law.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. It being for the public welfare that this ordinance be passed creates an emergency and public necessity, and the rule requiring this ordinance be read on three separate occasions be, and the same is hereby waived, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval and publication, as the law in such cases provides.
