

ORDINANCE NO. O-25-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING (b) of SECTION 106-33 OF CHAPTER 106 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HANOVER PARK TO EXPAND THE DISCOUNTED INFRASTRUCTURE SERVICE CHARGE FOR RESIDENTIAL ACCOUNTS TO INCLUDE METERS 1-INCH OR SMALLER, TO BE APPLICABLE TO BILLS ISSUED ON OR AFTER MARCH 1, 2025

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the President and Board of Trustees to provide a discount from the residential infrastructure service charge for a residential unit that is served by a 1-inch water meter provided its residents satisfy the criteria as set forth in (b) of Sec. 106-33 as set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanover Park, Cook and DuPage Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That (b) of section 106-33 of Chapter 106 of the Municipal Code of Hanover Park, as amended, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 106-33. -Water rates and infrastructure service charges.

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(b) The infrastructure service charge for each separate residential unit, which is:

- (1) Metered by an individual 1-inch or smaller water meter;
- (2) Occupied as the sole and exclusive residence by a customer who, or whose spouse is enrolled in the Benefit Access Program or is 65 years of age or older, or is certified as low income by uniform criteria by the township that serves the unit; and
- (3) For which there has been filed with the village a certification by such customer on a form to be provided by the village that he/she and/or his/her spouse are enrolled in the Benefit Access Program or are 65 years of age or older and that he/she/they occupy such unit as his/her/their residence shall be granted a discounted infrastructure service charge from the charge as appears in subsection (a) listed above.

The discounted infrastructure service charge for each one-month billing period and effective dates shall be as set forth below so long as such unit and occupants comply with the conditions in this subsection (b).

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SECTION 2: That each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is separable and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance nor any part thereof, other than the part affected by such decision.


SECTION 3: That except as to the amendments heretofore mentioned, all chapters and sections of the Municipal Code of Hanover Park shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall, by authority of the Village Board of the Village of Hanover Park, be published in pamphlet form. From and after ten days after said publication, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect, provided however, its provisions concerning the discount from the residential infrastructure service charge for 1-inch meters shall apply on, from, and after the issuing of bills commencing March 1, 2025. Bills heretofore issued and those to be issued prior to March 1, 2025, shall not be benefitted with the discount from the residential infrastructure service charge for 1-inch meters. Bills issued on or after March 1, 2025, shall be subject to the discount from the residential infrastructure service charge for 1-inch meters as provide for in Section 1 of this Ordinance.
