

**PROPOSED ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF VILLE PLATTE TO
ANNEX CERTAIN PROPERTY INTO THE CITY LIMITS**

An Ordinance proposing a change to the city limits of City of Ville Platte,

WHEREAS the Board of Aldermen in accordance with Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:172 shall by ordinance fix the city limits;

WHEREAS the Board of Aldermen have reviewed the need for expanding the city limits and believe it is in the best interest to expand its city limits to include that property described herein:

ITEM NO. 1

A certain parcel or tract of land, together with all improvements thereon and rights appertaining, located in Section 49, T-4-S, R-2-E, in Evangeline Parish, Louisiana.

Being further described as tract "12-P" containing 0.91 acres on that Plat of Survey for Verna D. Henry prepared by Doward Lee Guillory, Registered Land Surveyor, which is dated March 9, 1990, a copy of said plat is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Being further described as having a POINT OF BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of "12-G" which is at the tract's Southwest corner, thence, from said point proceeding in a generally northeasterly direction a distance of 226.4 feet to a point, thence in a southeasterly direction a distance of 152.8 feet to a point, thence in a southerly direction a distance of 241.5 feet to a point, thence in a northwesterly direction a distance of 200.00 feet back to the point of beginning.

ITEM NO. 2

A certain parcel or tract of land, together with all improvements thereon and rights appertaining, located in Section 49, T-4-S, R-2-E, in Evangeline Parish, Louisiana.

Being further described as tract "12-G" on that Plat of Survey for Verna D. Henry prepared by Doward Lee Guillory, Registered Land Surveyor, which is dated March 9, 1990, a copy of said plat is attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Being further described as having a 200.00 foot front on Prosper Street and heading in a northeasterly direction a distance of 300.00 feet running between parallel lines. Said tract is bounded to the north by tract "12-P", bounded to the east by tract "12-A", and bounded to the south by Prosper Street.

WHEREAS in case any one or more of the provisions of this ordinance shall for any reason be held to be illegal or invalid, such illegality or invalidity shall not affect any other provisions of said ordinance, but the same shall be construed and enforced as if such illegal or invalid provisions had not been contained therein. Any constitutional or statutory provisions enacted after the date of this ordinance which validate or make legal any provisions thereof shall be deemed to apply hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Ville Platte, State of Louisiana, in legal and regular and/or special session, acting as the "Governing Authority" of said City, after a public hearing with legal notice, that the herein described ordinance be adopted in accordance with its terms or as amended.
